- 1. Anything associated with alcohol use, obtaining or possession; if you are underage, will result in? *Ans: Lose of license for one year***
- 2. Cloverleaf intersections will always have? *Ans: One road crossing the other via bridge, with rt. hand exits***
- 3. Why is nighttime driving more dangerous? *Ans: Glare from headlights of vehicles, and lack of visibility***
- 4. The three steps in a lane change are? *Ans: Check rear view mirror, give turn signal, check blind spot***
- 5. The determining factors for passing are? *Ans: Do not pass at intersections, within 500 ft. of hills and curves, or where there is a solid yellow line***
- 6. If it starts to rain or drizzle while driving? *Ans: Slow down, use wipers and headlights, allow twice the normal following distance***
- 7. If your car stalls on the highway? *Ans: Move to the right side as much as possible, turn on the flashers or parking lights, hang something on side of car that will blow in breeze, raise hood, and do not stand close around the car***
- 8. If you are asked by the police to take a breath test? *Ans: You must take the test or request a blood test, if you do neither, you will lose your license for one full year***
- 9. How often should you check the mirrors? *Ans: Every 8 to 10 sec.***

10. *Seatbelts or child safety seats are required for?* **Ans: Anyone in car**
11. *When backing the vehicle straight back:*
Ans: Steer with the left hand, the right hand behind the passenger seat, looking over the right shoulder through the back window, move slowly no more than ten mph.
12. *Drivers' licenses or learners' permits are required for:*
Ans: For operation of a motor vehicle on any public roadway
13. *If you receive 12 points in three years:* **Ans: You may lose your license**
14. *Which offenses carry the most points against your license?*
Ans: Passing school bus loading or unloading, aggressive driving, either one is 5 points
15. *If you exceed more than 15 mph over the speed limit:*
Ans: You can lose your licenses
16. *If you exceed 70 mph:* **Ans: You may lose your licenses**
17. *Drunken persons are involved in what percent of fatal accidents?*
Ans: 38 percent
18. *Most pedestrian deaths involve, whom?*
Ans: Young children, older persons, people impaired
19. *When walking along roadways, at night:*
Ans: Walk facing traffic (left), wear or carry light or white colors
20. *Speed limits in town:* **Ans: 35 mph or otherwise posted**
21. *Speed limits on the highway:* **Ans: 55 mph or otherwise posted**
22. *School buses drive no faster than:* **Ans: 45 mph, maximum**

23. *Activity buses are restricted to: Ans: 55 mph, maximum*
24. *When rounding a curve a car tends to do what?
Ans: Move to the outside of the curve*
25. *When moving down long steep hills, how is speed controlled?
Ans: The car may be slowed down by shifting to a lower gear*
26. *When passing on a two lane roadway:
Ans: Legal pass zone, give signal, toot horn before overtaking*
27. *When making a turn from a single lane, into multiple lanes:
Ans: Always turn into the closer lane, going in your direction*
28. *Slower traffic on the interstate highway: Ans: Stay to the right*
29. *Accidents occur most frequently, where? Ans: Intersections*
30. *Cars in an intersection: Ans: Have the right of way to continue*
31. *At four way or all way stops:
Ans: The right of way goes to the vehicle to the right of you, if you arrive at the same time. Cars that arrive first, go first*
32. *When turning to the left?
Ans: You MUST yield to traffic, unless you have green arrow*
33. *Most frequent crash on interstate? Ans: Rear end collision*
34. *When driving on long trips, one should?
Ans: Stop every 100 mi. or two hours for a short break*
35. *Cars driving extremely slow on the highway are?
Ans: More likely to cause accidents*

36. *If you miss your exit on the interstate, you should?*
Ans: Go on to the next exit, never back up on the highway
37. *Low beam headlights are used, when?*
Ans: When meeting or following other cars and in bad weather
38. *When meeting a car with bright lights?*
Ans: Look far down road at white side line and blink your lights
39. *Roads are likely to be most slippery, when?*
Ans: The first few minutes after rain or drizzle starts to fall
40. *When driving in heavy fog or other bad weather?*
Ans: Slow down, increase following distance, use wipers and low beam headlights
41. *If your brakes fail?* *Ans: Pump your brake pedal, down shift gears, and apply the parking brake slowly*
42. *Changing a flat tire?* *Ans: Put transmission into park, apply the parking brake, block one of the wheels*
43. *If you have a tire blowout?*
Ans: No gas, no brakes, hold steering wheel firmly, car will slow and then apply brakes smoothly and gently
44. *If you run off the roadway onto the shoulder?*
Ans: No brake, gas or quick corrections of the steering wheel. When the car slows, give turn signal and ease onto road.

45. **Legal age for purchase, possession or consumption of alcohol?**
Ans: 21 years of age
46. **If you must brake on a slippery road?**
Ans: Apply the brake with a gentle squeezing application
47. **If your car should start to skid?** *Ans: Do not apply the gas or brake, turn the steering wheel in the direction that the rear end is skidding*
48. **If you are involved in an accident?** *Ans: If over \$1000 apparent damage or personal injury, the accident must be reported. If your vehicle will move under its own power, move over to the side of the road, but a picture of the accident scene would be a good idea, if possible. Call 911 or *HP, notify your insurance co.*
49. **Bicycles are supposed to do what?** *Ans: Follow traffic laws and regulations, as other vehicles are required to do. Stay to the right of the lanes or ride in bike lanes, if available.*
50. **Signals should be given how far in advance of the turn?**
Ans: 100 ft in advance in a 35 mph zone, 200 ft in 45 mph, and 500 ft in a 55 mph zone
51. **How often should mirrors be checked?**
Ans: About every 8 to 10 seconds
52. **What are the rules for traffic circles?** *Ans. Traffic in the circle has the right of way, traffic entering must yield*
53. **When a person takes the road test, they must have?**
Ans: Learners' permit and proof of insurance (DL-123 form)
54. **Every motor vehicle is inspected when?** *Ans: Every 12 months*

55. *A license tag should be purchased when? Ans: Every 12 months*
56. *If convicted of a DWI, while your license is revoked for a previous DWI, what happens? Ans: Your vehicle may be confiscated & sold*
57. *Alcohol affects what, first? Ans: Judgment*
58. *The only thing that sobers a drunk person? Ans: Time*
59. *During an average lifetime of driving, what is the chance of being involved in a crash? Ans: A one in three chance of a serious crash*
60. *If you see red reflectors on the road way? Ans: Move to the right and turn around ASAP, you are going the wrong way*
61. *A horn must be audible, how far from the car? Ans: 200 ft*
62. *The horn should only be used, how? Ans: Only as warning device*
63. *Defensive driving is driving to prevent crashes in spite of, what? Ans: The driving errors of others and adverse conditions*
64. *Good drivers always look (visual lead time) at least how far ahead? Ans: 12 to 15 seconds minimum*
65. *Work zones are marked with “orange colored devices”, do what? Ans: Pay attention, slow down, move cautiously with the traffic flow, keep following distances, be alert for flag person. It is a work zone even if no workers are present.*
66. *When exiting a vehicle on the side of a highway? Ans: Exit on the passenger side of the car.*
67. *Average reaction time is? Ans: ¾ ths. of a second*

68. Driving on ice and/or snow, do what?

Ans: Slow down, then slow down more.....allow at least 8-10 seconds following distance, no quick movements, look ahead and think ahead. Slow the car by gearing down and then apply the brake softly.

69. If you cancel your auto insurance?

Ans: License tag must be returned to license tag office, first.

70. In hard packed snow, you should?

Ans: Use tires and/or snow tires.

71. If you are driving in heavy snowfall, rain, or fog, use?

Ans: Low beam headlights

72. Alcohol related deaths are accounted for?

Ans: In 38% of traffic crashes

Ans: You may attend a driver improve. class, it removes 3 pts.

Ans: 35 mph

Ans: Go to DMV, pay restoration fee and reapply for license

Ans: 1) passing zone 2) nothing coming or plenty of safe space

Ans: Down shift transmission to help control speed
86. *If you unintentionally run off the road, you should?*
Ans: No gas, no brake, let car slow then gently steer onto road
87. *Expect farm vehicles on rural roads to travel no faster than?*
Ans: Speeds of around 15-20 mph
88. *When entering a traffic circle, you should?* **Ans: Yield to others**
89. *If there is an emergency vehicle on the side of the road with flashing lights (red, blue, or yellow), do what?* **Ans: Move over a lane if possible, or slow down and move over some**

90. *School buses must stop at? Ans: All railroad crossings*
91. *In city traffic, you should always?*
Ans: Be alert for other driver' quick stops
92. *If a school bus stops to load or unload passengers on a two road with a center turn lane, who stops? Ans: Everyone*

Ans: Slow, look, listen and stop if necessary; never on tracks

Ans: You must always stop
