Friday, August 31, 2018, we will make our way to Bryson City, North Carolina for a day full of excitement beginning with a train ride with the Great Smokey Mountain Railroad. The historic steam powered #1702 has returned to the rails. One of only two left in the US, this world's largest engine dates back to 1942 where the engine's construction was an official commissioned WWII Steam Engine Plan. We have a 10:30 departure time!



Our boarding pass directs us to open seating in an enclosed car; windows that open for fresh air and taking photos, are heated and have ceiling fans for our comfort. The **Tuckasegee River Excursion** provides a calming ride through the countryside of Western North Carolina. **Our boxed lunch will be available on the train.** We will have a short layover in Dillsboro to allow the train time to turnaround for the return trip. While in this historic town, we will be able to shop or visit the train museum. We will return to this beautiful town for our dinner reservation at the **Jarrett House**. Our return trip to Bryson City will be passing the famous train wreck site featured in the movie "The Fugitive".
