POTENTIAL COMPLICATIONS FOR ANY REMOVAL
ALVEOLECTOMY (BONE TRIMMING)
FRENECTOMY

- SOFT TISSUE INJURY: eg. TONGUE, CHEEK, LIPS, ETC.
- BONEY INJURY: eg. FRACTURE OF MANDIBLE, TUBEROSITY, BUCCAL BONE, ETC.
- DAMAGE TO ADJACENT TEETH AND STRUCTURES: eg. LARGE FILLINGS, CROWNS, ETC.
- PERMANENT TO TEMPORARY PARAESTHESIA (NUMBNESS) : THIS IS ESPECIALLY COMMON IN POSTERIOR MANDIBLE.
- POSSIBLE COMPLICATIONS FROM ANAESTHESIA: INCREASED HEART RATE, INCREASED BLOOD PRESSURE THAT IN RARE CASES MAY REQUIRE EMERGENCY TREATMENT.
- ROOT TIPS MAY BE RETAINED IF TOO DIFFICULT TO REMOVE OR SMALL ENOUGH TO LEAVE IN PLACE.
- PERFORATION OF SINUS (TEAR THAT CAUSES OPENING) THAT MAY OR MAY NOT COMPLETELY HEAL AND WOULD REQUIRE REFERRAL TO AN ORAL SURGEON

POST OPP COMPLICATIONS:

- *SWELLING
- *BRUISING
- *PAIN
- *BLEEDING
- *DRY SOCKET (LOSS OF BLOOD CLOT)
- *BONE CHIPS
