



Pest Control and Lawn Care
CLEAN OUT PROCEDURE

1. STEP ONE

- A) It mandatory to make necessary arrangements for all living things (people , animals , birds , reptiles , aquatic creatures) to be vacated from premise before any treatment can be performed . If anyone has a medical condition such as : pregnancy , asthma , heart conditions , or taking medication of any type , please contact the office and speak with the management or a ChemScape representative .
- B) All cabinets and cupboards are to be completely cleaned out . This is to include all shelf paper . Place all items on a table and cover them with either plastic or a sheet .
- C) Cabinets , cupboards , and all surrounding cracks and crevices are to be treated with a residual insecticide followed by the application of a flushing agent to help in controlling roaches . * Please note that this treatment will not provide an instant kill of all pests.
- D) Sanitation reports will be presented as a corrective measure.
- E) It is mandatory to be evacuated for 3-4 hours due to the nature of the pesticides being applied . This is required for your safety and well being .

2. STEP TWO (7 Days later as stated on the label)

- A) An inspection will be conducted on all areas treated . In the event that it is found necessary to have a re-treatment , it will be scheduled at this time .
- B) In the event of re-treatment a flushing of all cabinets and cupboards may be necessary . All cabinets and cupboards will need to be cleaned out for this treatment .
- C) Insect monitors will be installed at this time to insure pest elimination .
- D) A second sanitation report may be issued if needed at this time .

3. STEP THREE (IF NEEDED)

- A) If a spot treatment was performed in step two , then baiting and dusting will be done at this time .
- B) More insect monitors may be placed to better track pest activity.
