

LONGVIEW PART TIME KENNEL HELP

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) **MUST** be able to work **WEEKENDS, EVERY MAJOR HOLIDAY & ALL SUMMER** (from Memorial Weekend to Labor Day Weekend).

NO EXCEPTIONS!

That is when Longview is the busiest and you get the most hours.

- 2) Must be able to work within the hours of 3PM to 6PM on weekdays; 8AM to 11AM and/or 3PM to 6PM weekends, summer and holiday times.
(Average about 2 shifts per week during slow times & 5-10 shifts per week during busy holiday times.)
- 3) Must like both cats & dogs and not be afraid of any animals.

DUTIES INCLUDE BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

- 1) Clean cat crates, change dirty cat bedding, wash litter boxes, feed and water cats, wash bowls and sweep & mop cat kennel area. Pet/play with cats.
- 2) Feed dogs, clean inside and outside run areas, change dirty dog bedding, water dogs (inside and outside bowls and buckets), **POOP SCOOP** inside and outside dog runs. Sweep & mop dog runs and kennel buildings. Medicate dogs and/or cats (We will teach you this.). Wash dog bowls. Hose/power wash outside kennel area when weather permits. Clean up all messes inside & out of dog kennels. Pet/play with dogs.
- 3) Laundry, fill bird feeders, file papers and cards, write out grooming lists, make shampoo for grooming, hold dogs or cats for groomer or staff, let dogs in & out in runs. Walk dogs outside even in rainy/snowy weather.
- 4) Notice signs of distress/illness in dogs or cats and alert management.
- 5) This job entails allot of physical labor & ALLOT cleaning.

All of these duties will be taught but a general knowledge of animals is best. You must be motivated to work hard and take initiative in performing the needed duties.

Salary: Starts at MINIMUM WAGE and goes up with experience. Raises come periodically with excellent work rating.
